Tom Hills is a graduate of Iowa State University and was commissioned through the US Navy Aviation Reserve Officer Candidate Program in 1981.

During more than 26 years of service in the US Navy, he served as Squadron Commander VFA-34, Assistant Chief of Staff for Operations on USS George Washington Battle Group, and Commander of Training Air Wing 2, among other assignments.
